## 2021 VIRTUAL CAMPMEETING REPORT

### Introduction

Due to COVID-19 pandemic, the 2021 Campmeeting was held virtually on 22 – 29 August 2021. The Campmeeting was preceded by One week of prayer meetings to invoke God's blessings on the online event and to seek God's intervention to make the convention hitch-free especially regarding the digital technology associated with the virtual meetings.

The virtual Campmeeting Workers Conference was held on Friday, 20<sup>th</sup> August 2021 beginning at 10.00am. While ministers and workers from Accra Zone gathered at Aplaku for the conference, the workers and ministers from all other branch churches were requested to gather at their zonal headquarters for the zoom-mediated online conference.

### Workers Conference

The 2021 Campmeeting Workers Conference Lesson was on the theme *Remove Not the Ancient Landmark*, which was taken from Proverbs 22: 28 and which was the same lesson used for the WECA 2021 Campmeeting Workers Conference. The workers were taken through the definition and meaning of *Landmark* and its spiritual application. How to retain the Old Landmark and the benefits of it were further expounded to the workers.

Workers from all the six administrative zones (Accra; Ada; Western; Northern; Eastern; and Central) participated in the event.

### Campmeeting Teachings and Sermons

The 2021 Campmeeting was held under the theme: *Earnestly Contend for the Faith* (Jude 3) and that was the topic used for the First Sunday of the convention. Because the Campmeeting was for one week, we held teachings and services throughout the week including on Monday. The following teaching topics were



presented during the Campmeeting: The Foundational Christian Experiences; Backsliding In The Heart & Apostasy; The Christian Home; Divine Healing (God's Promises To Heal The Sick); and Self-Denial & Humility. On the last Sunday, we treated Readiness for the Rapture (Watchfulness and Steadfastness). All the services and teachings were live-streamed on the internet and the Lord blessed in a special way. Revival and Evangelistic Services were held on Sunday – Friday. Youth Services were held on the first Sunday, Wednesday and Friday, while Children's Services were held on Tuesday and Thursday.

The teachings and sermons were inspiring and challenging and many worshippers prayed after each service.

### **Campmeeting Music Concert**

The Campmeeting Music Concert was held on Sunday, 29 August 2021 by 3.00pm on the theme *I Must Tell Jesus*. As a result, both the Youth Service and Farewell Service could not be held.

Although the Campmeeting Music Concert was held at Aplaku, Kumasi, Western, Ada and Central Zones were each able to record two local songs, which were re-played during the event.

The Campmeeting Music Concert featured works from the music masters including *Hallelujah* from "Exultate" by W.A. Mozart; *The King Shall Rejoice* by G.F. Handell; *Concerto* in C Major by Antonio Vivaldi; *Tempo Di Menuetto* by Fritz Kreisler; *Czardas* by Vittorio Monti; *Rodeau* by Jean-Joseph Mouret; *How Excellent* by W.J. Kirkpatrick; and *Second Waltz* from Suites No. 2 by Dmitry Shostakovich. Local Airs were also presented during the concert, which included *Gyatabruwa* by Osei Boateng; *Mida Akpe* & *Dzidzorm* by Ken Kafui.

### **Campmeeting Statistics**

Those who could be present at Aplaku for the meetings were in attendance, while majority of the people were internet audience. We thank God that our meetings were well attended. Peak attendance was on the first Sunday, 22 August 2021, with 2,609 persons joining the Devotional Service.



Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, we could not hold the ordinances of Water Baptism, Lord’s Supper and Washing of Saints’ Feet. However, the Lord compensated us with a total of 1,558 blessings distributed as follows:
