EXECUTIVE SUMMARY OF THE 2023 NATIONAL YOUTH CAMP

The National Youth Camp was scheduled between 3rd to 5th March 2023. Unlike the 2022 youth camp where only 3 zones were allowed to participate because of Covid-19 restrictions, all zones were allowed to fully participate. Prior to the program, the National Youth Executives observed series of online prayer meetings to pray down the power of God.

Opening ceremony

The program started with singspirations interspersed with scripture readings. Overseer then charged the youth to make use of the time spent at the camp grounds to pray through their graces to pull down the Exceeding Abundant blessings of God. He entreated the youth to take advantage of the opportunity they have to know God at an early stage. He also encouraged the youth to have a purpose for attending the 2023 youth camp and make sure their purpose is met before the camp ends.

Day 2: Saturday, 4th March 2023

Day two (2) began with a prayer session dubbed 'PUSH' (Pray Until Something Happens) which was followed by a clean-up exercise.

Bible Study

A Bible study on the theme of the camp titled 'Abundant Life' was studied. It highlighted the means of obtaining abundant life in Christ, the means of sustaining that abundant life and the benefits an abundant life in Christ brings to one's life. The youth were challenged to also seize the opportunity to seek an abundant life in Christ which will translate into abundance in all aspects of their lives.

Bible Quiz

A Bible Quiz was held concurrently with Sunday School Teachers Conference. The quiz had representation from four zones only and the Western zone emerged as winners. Questions were based on lesson book 28 and the first 7 pages of the document "AFC-Ghana History."

ASPIRE

A program dubbed 'ASPIRE' was held for various categories of people which included: Undergraduates, Graduates, Professionals/Working-class/ Career people, SHS students and JHS students. The aim of the program was to enlighten people on the key things to consider when deciding on a career path. It also highlighted ways to thrive in one's chosen career. There was a perspective sharing and questions and answers session where a panel threw more light on lessons learnt at the various class sessions.

Evangelistic Service

A Revival and Evangelistic Service was held in the evening led by Bro. Joseph Amponsah of the Northern zone. God sent down a mighty revival as many souls were blessed.

Talent Show

Talent Show was organized in the evening where young men and women displayed their God-given talents through musical renditions (vocal/instrumentation), drama, spoken word and poetry recitals.

Awards Night

An Awards Night was held to award winners of the camp anthem challenge, quiz competition and talent show. Prizes included Bibles, gold, silver, and bronze medals.

Sunday Service

Sunday School was held in the morning with the youth taking charge. It was followed by the Devotional Service and the WECA Youth Leader, Bro. Abraham Popogbe gave a sermon on the theme "More than Enough." The key verse was taken from Luke 15:11-24. Just like the prodigal son having his father's riches and yet found no permanent joy after leaving home, Bro Abraham reminded the youth that Jesus is more than enough and that there was abundance of blessings in remaining in the sheepfold of God.

Music concert

To climax the youth camp, the Apostolic Faith Church Youth Choir performed a musical concert themed "Great God of Wonders."

Conclusions

The departure of delegates started after the Devotional Service. We thank God for the success of the camp and for pouring down his bountiful blessings. We pray that He will retain the souls that were snatched from the pit of hell and that He continues to shower His Exceeding Abundant blessings on the youth wherever they go.
